Registered and active parishioners of Saint Brigid of Kildare Parish may qualify for the parishioner rate of tuition for their children. Registered and active parishioners:

- Participate in the liturgical and sacramental life of the parish
- Regularly attend and participate in Sunday Mass
- Commit to the parish through gifts of time, talent and treasure by participating in the Tapestry program
- Actively work to participate in the mission of the parish and the Church

Cost-Based Tuition, Need-Based Assistance

Saint Brigid of Kildare School uses a cost-based model to set tuition rates. This means that tuition is determined based on the actual cost of operating the school. The parish is committed to supporting all families who desire Catholic education for their children. Diocesan assistance and Emmaus Road Scholarship Funds (SGO) is open to all socioeconomic and religious backgrounds (grades K-8), and St. Brigid assistance is open to all Catholic families (grades K-8). Interested families use a FACTS application similar to college tuition assistance. This application is due in March each year, and we encourage all families to apply. In addition, grants are available through our Oak Society for active parish families. More information is available at stbrigidofkildare.com/tuition.

One Tuition Cost. No Extra Fees or Fundraisers.

Cost-based tuition also means that the cost of tuition includes everything – there are no extra technology, activity, playground, homeroom, enrollment or other hidden fees. The only thing we'll ask you to consider donating to each year is the Annual Fund, which covers after school programs, extracurriculars, school performances and field trips. This also means we do not hold fundraisers – we won't ask your children to sell things like wrapping paper, magazines or candy because our tuition rates and Annual Fund cover the costs of all extra activities.

Payment Options – can be made on the 5th or 20th of the month:

- Full Pay Plan made in July (\$20 processing fee)
- Semi-Annual payments made July and December (\$20 FACTS processing fee)
- Quarterly Payments made July, October, January, April (\$50 FACTS processing fee)
- 10 Monthly payments made July-April (\$50 FACTS processing fee) 12 monthly payments made July-June (\$50 FACTS processing fee)
