

# Tuition & EdChoice

Ohio's Educational Choice (EdChoice) Scholarship Program is now accessible to all Ohioans! Thanks to sweeping changes outlined in HB 33 and signed into law on July 3, 2023 by Governor DeWine, EVERY student now has the opportunity to attend a participating Catholic school for less.

Families at 450% or below of the Federal Poverty Guideline will receive the maximum scholarship allowed by law. Those at 451% or more will receive a portion of the full scholarship amount, dependent on their household income and family size.

We are asking ALL families to consider applying for EdChoice dollars. If your family is in need of additional support beyond the EdChoice Scholarship amount, please apply for tuition assistance through FACTS, which is due March 15 prior to the upcoming school year.

# How to Apply for EdChoice at St. Brigid (New Applicants):

# A complete Scholarship Request Form for EACH eligible student in grades K-8 who is enrolled in our school. PLEASE NOTE: the student's name on the application must match the birth certificate exactly. A copy of the student's birth certificate A current proof of address. A utility bill must have both the "billing" and "service" address listed, and the bill must be within the last 90 days. Electric, gas, and water bills are acceptable. This Check Deposit Consent Form (if you do not complete this form, you will need to come in each month to manually sign the back of the EdChoice check). Finally, complete the Income Verification process online (If you have already completed the Income Verification for the 2023-24 school year for another child already enrolled, you do not need to resubmit. If your income has changed, you may resubmit through your Income Verification app in your OHID.) Income Verification Instructions

The application opens February 1 for the upcoming school year.

**Renewal applications** also open February 1 for the upcoming school year and include only a renewal form and proof of address. An income verification is optional.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Please note, in order to continue to receive your scholarship, children may not have more than 20 unexcused absences per year (<u>click here for a definition of unexcused absences</u>) and are required to complete the STAR assessments in grades K-8 and the Ohio state science test in grades 5 and 8, as given by the school.
