What is RaiseRight? (Formerly ShopwithScrip)

Earn credit towards your child's 2027-2028 tuition by buying electronic or physical gift cards from RaiseRight to pay for your everyday shopping and spending year-round including groceries, dining out, home improvement, and everything in between.

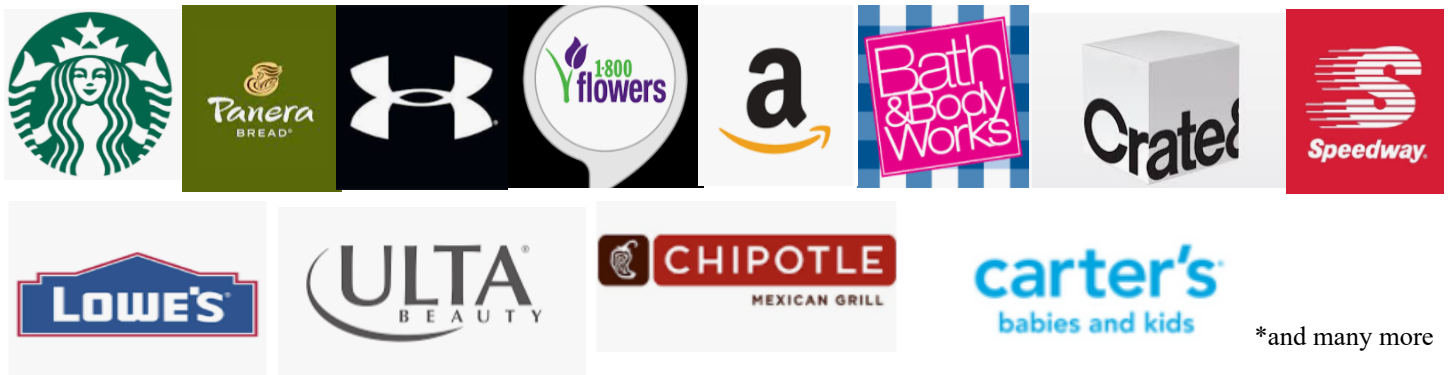
How it Works:

- Use the RaiseRight website or app to order gift cards at face value from 1000+ brands
 - Pick from eGift cards and physical gift cards
 - eGift cards are available within minutes
 - "Ship to Home" physical gift card shipping is available for a \$.50 shipping fee per order plus a \$.50 handling fee per card (up to 16 per order).
 - Pay via a linked bank account
 - \$.29 fee on each transaction
 - Earn from 1-to-20% on every gift card you buy
- One hundred percent (**100%**) of your RaiseRight earnings from **April 1, 2026 - March 31, 2027** is deducted from **your** family's Saint Brigid tuition for the **2027-2028** school year.

Many retailers offer a mobile option, making the need for physical cards unnecessary and the ability to make money towards tuition super easy! Just download the RaiseRight app and tuition credit is always at your fingertips! (The app is available via the App Store or Google Play.)

Who can use RaiseRight?

Parents/guardians of current St Brigid students who will still be enrolled at St Brigid for the 2027-2028 school year may use this program. Each St Brigid family may only have one account. All earnings from April 1, 2026, to March 31, 2027 will be deducted from your 2027-2028 tuition.

THREE different ways to make RaiseRight work for your family

1. You can place "[Ship To Home](#)" orders for traditional one-time use physical gift cards.
 - a. Great for gifts!
2. You can order reloadable cards to which additional money can be electronically added at any time.
 - a. Great for gas cards or routine purchases
3. You can purchase electronic gift cards 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
 - a. Great for online shopping or you can even order while you're waiting in line at a store!

How to sign up

- 1) Before creating your account, please contact your RaiseRight Chair for a special enrollment code. During the sign-up process you will need to link yourself as a member of Saint Brigid School with this code.
 - (a) In the email include your name, as well as the name and grade of your student(s) and send to your RaiseRight Chair:

 - (b) The program is limited to parents and guardians of current students. Each family may only have one account (ie. Grandparents/other family or friends may not have their own account, but you may decide how you let them access your family account)

Join an existing program

All you need is your organization's unique enrollment code. If you don't know your code, you can ask your program's coordinator.

- 3) After entering St. Brigid's code, you will be prompted to select a username and password.
 - a) You will then be asked to enter information such as your name, address, phone number, students name and grade (if you have multiple children, you can just enter one), email address, and security questions.
 - 4) You will then be required to link a bank account.
 - a) This is the **only** way to pay for your order. Your payment will be electronically deducted from your checking account (with a \$0.29 fee per transaction). We do not accept checks as payment.
 - b) You can instantly link your bank account if you have online accounts set up, or you can manually link an account (which will take 1-2 business days).
 - c) For extra security, you can set up a 2-step authorization to a phone.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I receive my gift cards?

RaiseRight Electronic gift cards and reloadable orders may be placed at any time and will be available in your virtual wallet/email. Download the RaiseRight app to take full advantage of the program!

Reloadable gift cards (that are already in your possession) will be loaded overnight if the order is placed by 3 p.m. EST.

How do I pay?

Pay by linking your bank account to your RAISERIGHT account. There is a \$0.29 with each transaction.

How do I get my tuition credits?

100% of the credits you earn will be applied towards your St Brigid of Kildare 2027-2028 tuition. Tuition credit will be applied once a year. The order period is from April 1, 2026, to March 31, 2027. Your RAISERIGHT credit will appear on your 2027-2028 tuition statement.

How can I track my credit balance?

You can track your account at www.RaiseRight.com using the "my account" dashboard.

What happens if I order the wrong cards?

In general, sales are final and not eligible for refund. Please contact the RaiseRight Chair with any questions.

What happens if the wrong cards are in my envelope?

If you did not order the cards you received, immediately contact the RaiseRight Chair to resolve the issue.

Can I participate in RaiseRight if my child is in eighth grade?

No. You will need to begin participating in the RaiseRight program at either Bishop Watterson or St. Charles high schools beginning in April of your child's 7th grade school year.

What happens if we leave Saint Brigid School for another school?

Any rebates earned will be donated to the St. Brigid Home and School Association.

What if I am still not sure how to make RaiseRight work best for my family?

If your payment is returned or rejected for any reason, there will be a fee of up to \$30.00, plus we will either CANCEL your order, or we will CHARGE YOU for the face value of your order.
